

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Purpose of processing: Ensuring compliance with obligations arising from contractual relationships of the controller with its business partners; an essential component of the monitoring of the controller's employees pursuant to specific legislation.

Legal basis for the processing: Legitimate interests of a controller pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (General Data Protection Regulation).

Legitimate interests of a controller: The legitimate interest of the controller to perform monitoring of employees stemming from the specific nature of the controller's activities, which include, among other things, the operation of critical infrastructure elements within the meaning of a special law, with the related processing of personal data of external parties (data subjects); efficient emergency response.

Recipients or categories of recipients: Lawyers; Courts

Period for which personal data will be stored: 1 year

Transfer of personal data to a third country or international organization: Will not be exercised.

Automated decision-making and profiling: Will not be exercised.

Rights of the data subject:

The data subject has **the right of access to personal data, the right to rectification of the data, the right to erasure, the right to restriction of processing and the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority**, being the Office for Personal Data Protection of the Slovak Republic.
Detailed information on the rights of the data subjects and on the manner in which they can be

The data subject has also the **RIGHT TO OBJECT TO processing of personal data** concerning him or her, **including the right to object to profiling**.

In such an event, the **controller shall no longer process the personal data** unless the controller demonstrates

- a) compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject,
or
- b) for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.
