Purpose of processing: Fulfilling the controller's duties in the area of occupational health and safety, including fire and radiation protection duties.

Legal basis for the processing: The processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject within the meaning of Article 6(1)(c) of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (General Data Protection Regulation), in particular, the Act No 355/2007 on the protection, promotion and development of public health and Act No 124/2006 on occupational health and safety and other related laws.

Recipients/recipient categories: Slovak Legal Metrology; Labour Inspectorate; Social Security Fund; Health Insurance Funds; healthcare providers; Occupational Health Service; Public Health Office of the Slovak Republic; Police; lawyers; courts; Fire and Rescue Service and other entities to which personal data are provided by the controller by virtue of law; expert consultants and advisers bound by a legal and/or contractual confidentiality obligation; OHS and fire protection coordinators during the implementation of projects.

The period for which the personal data will be stored: One year following the year to which the data relate in case of protection from serious contagious diseases; 5 years following the year to which the data relate in case of other diseases.

Request for the disclosure of personal data and potential consequences of non-disclosure: The provision of personal data is a legal requirement. The data subject is legally obliged to provide his or her personal data. Non-provision of personal data would prevent the proper performance of the controller's OHS and fire protection obligations and could potentially lead to disallowing the performance of duties by the contractor or to non-compliance with the controller's legal obligations.

Transfer of personal data to a third country or an international organisation: None.

Automated decision-making, including profiling: None.

The data subject's rights:

The data subject has the **right of access to personal data**; **right to rectification, erasure and restriction of processing of personal data**; and **right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority**, which is the Office for Personal Data Protection of the Slovak Republic.
