

Commission Regulation (EU) 2017/460 of 16 March 2017 establishing a network code on harmonised transmission tariff structures for gas (hereinafter referred to as „TAR NC“)

Art. 30(1)(c)(iii) of the TAR NC – Information on the reference prices and other prices applicable at points other than those referred to in Article 29 TAR NC

In line with the Article 30(1)(c)(iii) of the TAR NC the following information should be published:

„the reference prices and other prices applicable at points other than those referred to in Article 29“

For the tariff period beginning on 01 January 2022, the information under Art. 30(1)(c)(iii) of the TAR NC are published under the price decision of the Regulatory Office for Network Industries No. 0040/2019/P as of 29 May 2019 (point 4) and price decision of the Regulatory Office for Network Industries No. 0068/2022/P as of 28 December 2021. Pursuant to the given price decisions, the Regulatory Office for Network Industries determined that “according to Art. 2(1) TAR NC the final reference prices will not be the reserve prices for yearly standard capacity products for the entry/exit point Veľké Kapušany, entry/exit point Budince and the entry/exit point domestic point, as the Regulatory Office for Network Industries did not take a decision to apply the Commission Regulation (EU) 2017/459 of 16 March 2017 establishing a network code on capacity allocation mechanisms in gas transmission systems and repealing Regulation (EU) No 984/2013 at those entry/exit points from/to third countries. Reserve prices for the above-mentioned entry/exit points will be determined on the basis of the final reference prices and the relevant legislation of the Slovak Republic issued on the basis thereof, which is the Decree of the Regulatory Office for Network Industries No. 376/2021 Coll., amending the Decree of the Regulatory Office for Network Industries No. 223/2016 Coll., which established the price regulation in the gas sector, as amended by the Decree No. 206/2018 Coll., which became effective from 20 October 2021 (hereinafter referred only to as “Decree No. 376/2021 Coll.”) and according to § 23b par. 1 of the Decree No. 376/2021 Coll. according to the adjustments effective from 20 October 2021, the implementation of price regulation for 2022 is being carried out for the first time.”

Following the above mentioned, for the tariff period beginning on 01 January 2022, the reserve prices for access to the transmission network and gas transmission, as well as the conditions of their application for entry/exit points Veľké Kapušany, Budince and domestic point were approved by the price decision of the Regulatory Office for Network Industries No. 0068/2022/P as of 28 December 2021.
