Request for the disclosure of personal data and potential consequences of non-disclosure: The controller will process personal data on the legal ground of compliance with legal obligations. When the disclosure of personal data is a legal requirement, the controller must disclose them.

The data subject's rights:

The data subject has the **right of access to personal data**; **right to rectification, erasure and restriction of processing of personal data**; and **right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority**, which is the Office for Personal Data Protection of the Slovak Republic.

The data subject has the RIGHT TO OBJECT to the processing of personal data relating to him or her, including objecting to profiling.

If such objection is made, **the controller shall no longer process the personal data** unless it demonstrates

- compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject; or
- grounds for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.

Purpose of processing: Monitoring the controller's technology building sites, including construction sites and structures under construction on the basis of a relevant permit issued under the applicable building administration laws for the purposes of protecting the controller's property and/or ensuring the safety of employees and other persons.

Legal basis for the processing: The controller's legitimate interest within the meaning of Article 6(1)(f) of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data General Data Protection Regulation).

The Controller's legitimate interests: Protection of the controller's property; safeguarding the safety and health of employees and other persons; control of the entry into and exit from the controller's premises; prevention of the movement of unauthorised persons in the controller's premises.

Recipients/recipient categories: Private security service; law enforcement authorities; courts.

The period for which the personal data will be stored: 15 days of the date of acquisition.
