**Purpose of processing:** Compliance with the controller's legal obligations in the supplier selection and subcontractor registration, including demonstrating professional competence, in the public procurement process including providing documents during the performance of external audits and other statutory inspections.

**Legal basis for the processing:** The processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject within the meaning of Article 6(1)(c) of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data General Data Protection Regulation), in particular, the Act No 343/2015 on public procurement and other related laws.

**Recipients/recipient categories:** The Office for Public Procurement; external auditors; lawyers; courts and other similar entities; entities to which the controller provides personal data on the basis of law; expert consultants and advisers bound by a legal and/or contractual confidentiality obligation.

The period for which the personal data will be stored: 10 years following the year to which the data relate.

**Personal data category:** The controller processes mainly contact and identification details such as the degree, name, surname, job position, address, electronic mail address at work, telephone number and personal data concerning professional competence.

**Source of personal data:** A business partner's representative providing personal data of its employees or of its subcontractors' employees to the controller.

Request for the disclosure of personal data and potential consequences of non-disclosure: The provision of personal data is a legal requirement. The data subject is legally obliged to provide his or her personal data; without such provision, the controller would be unable to properly evaluate the candidate in accordance with the relevant laws of general application.

Transfer of personal data to a third country or an international organisation: None.

Automated decision-making, including profiling: None.

## The data subject's rights:

The data subject has the **right of access to personal data**; **right to rectification, erasure and restriction of processing of personal data**; and **right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority**, which is the Office for Personal Data Protection of the Slovak Republic.
